We are looking for volunteers to run the Sheffield and Steventon Marking Stations in 2026. If no volunteers are forthcoming, then these marking stations will not be open next year. Existing volunteers are retiring, after many years of service, and we thank them for their commitment.

The marking stations don't have to be replaced, or be in the same place as they currently are. Congleton, Leyland & Alveley will remain open in 2026 for Midlands and more Northerly flyers, and Bristol, Saffron Walden & Portsmouth will remain open for the Southern flyers.

However, if anyone would like to take on the running of a marking station in their area, please contact the Race Manager with your proposal. Any marking station should be at least 50 miles from another one, and as things stand at the moment, you will also need a reasonably priced vet. Base units for Benzing, Bricon, Unikon and iPigeon are available if required, and there are a couple of printers which could be relocated.

The deadline for applications is 1st December 2025.
